Ministry Description

Ministry Call:

The Student Discipleship Team is a group of adult volunteers committed to teaching and equipping high school students. Leaders in this team will act on our understanding that we are to 'love the LORD your God with all your mind' by leading students through the educational side of discipleship.

Qualifications:

1. A growing and maturing relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.
2. A sense of calling from the Lord to serve and teach youth.
3. The enthusiasm to serve as an active part of the Christ UMC youth ministry program.
4. Willingness to use gifts and talents in service to the kingdom of God.
5. A passion to teach students who God is and who he has called us to be.

Responsibilities:

1. Work with a team of adults in planning and implementing a yearlong curriculum.
2. Regularly attend Sunday night classes, and be present at meetings deemed necessary for your team's ministry.
3. Have each week's lesson prepared in advance, along with any necessary resources and teaching aids.
4. Prayerfully work to develop a system of spiritual nurture, guidance and direction available to students who desire deeper spiritual growth.
5. Be a Christian example in conduct and speech and committed to nurturing your own life of faith.
6. Strive to grow personally in your understanding of God and God's word.
7. Let high school youth director and other team members know when you cannot attend a team meeting or class.
8. Seek and pray for spiritual fullness in Christ for yourself, members of your team, and for the students of Christ UMC.

In return, the High School Youth Director and fellow volunteers agree to:

1. Guide and support you in nurturing your own spiritual fullness in Christ through this ministry call.
2. Keep you well informed of all Youth Ministry plans and programs.
3. Provide you with any training and resources you might need to carry out your team's ministry.
4. Pray for you.
5. Provide child-care for your children during planning meetings and your team's programs.
6. Pay any expenses incurred as a result of youth ministry programs.
7. Listen to your needs and concerns about your ministry.
