Right now, we are getting ready to send sixty students to the Dominican Republic to work with Haitian refugees in the sugar cane fields that house one of the poorest populations of this third world country, and we would love to have you share this experience.

Support college students seeking Christ AND get some yard/house work done in the process. Here's how it works: they work for you and what you pay them goes towards their Spring Break Mission Trip. As these college students serve you, you have a chance to serve them through financial support, providing lunch and getting to know the students.

The breakdown:

- You donate a *minimum* of \$100/student towards their Spring Break Mission Trip (you can pay more). All donations are tax deductible.
- You provide lunch for students. Enjoy the chance to speak their love language –food.
- Take the opportunity hear the students' unique stories and excitement about the upcoming mission trip.
